As outlined in recent issues of Wheel Torque, the continuing threat to the enjoyment of our hobby and recreational activities is the potential loss of convenient access to affordable fossil fuels and the legal removal of our right to use older vehicles on our roads. To effectively combat such threats and obtain acceptable concessions from the transport authorities will require the combined strength of the membership of the FOMC.

In addition to reviewing the activities of the past year the AGM is an opportunity to continue strengthening our volunteer team. So if you have a member with the knowledge and skills to assist our interaction with government officials then please encourage them to stand for an Executive position. The Federation Executive meets quarterly as necessary, and reasonable travel expenses are reimbursed.
