We have also launched the "NZ Heritage Vehicle Survey" (NZHVS) project, quantifying the economic, social, cultural and recreational benefits of our hobby to New Zealand society, ably led by executive member Michael Anderson of the MG Car Club.

We have been working on internal cost-efficiency gains and will soon be refreshing the website, with more interactive capability, where topics and concerns can be raised in a secure environment and discussed amongst members.

Your executive looks for eager minds and new ideas, so your club's nominations are welcome.
